

# The Foundry Church Sunday Morning Social Distancing Procedures and Expectations Updated 7-1-2020\*

As we begin to reopen, we're taking all the necessary actions to help keep our church body safe and healthy. **Please review the following procedures and expectations that will be strictly enforced.** Please arrive by 9:40 am so that we can provide any additional instruction and get set before our pre-service stream begins.

**\*Seminole County has a face mask mandate.  
Masks are required when entering the building.**

**If you have any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, sore throat, shortness of breath), or if you have been in contact with someone who has, please stay home.**

## **Staff Precautions**

- Our staff and greeters are checking temperature daily as well as keeping a log of our interactions in compliance with CDC regulations.
- All high touch areas are cleaned multiple times a day at regular intervals. We will also work to ensure that we eliminate as many touch points as possible from your Sunday morning experience by propping doors, revisiting communion, and by redirecting the flow of foot traffic. Please help us stay safe by abiding by all written and verbal instructions. **Arriving at The Foundry Church**
  - As you approach the building from your vehicle, observe if other groups are arriving at the same time as you. If there are families waiting to enter, please utilize the marked lines under the awning on the playground side of the building, and a greeter will let you know when you and your family can enter.
  - Family groups will be allowed to enter the building one at a time through one set of double doors and asked to follow the arrows on the floor as they approach the main auditorium. All doors will be propped open so that you do not have to interact with frequently touched areas. **Hand sanitizer will be readily available at all touch points.**
  - Family groups will enter the main auditorium through the side entrance immediately off of the lobby.
  - The hallway towards the main auditorium entrance and main restrooms will be blocked off, as well as the entire kids wing.
  - The Foundry Coffeehouse will be off limits and closed until further notice.
  - You will be given individual, pre-packaged communion upon your arrival for use during service.
- You will be seated with your family, and all family groups will be seated 6 feet apart in the main auditorium. We will use metal chairs rather than our cloth chairs for simpler disinfection.

### **Attending Worship Service**

- Our services will still be catered primarily to our online audience throughout our testing period. You may have to reposition in your seat in order to fully see all elements of service. Our auditorium layout more closely resembles a television studio rather than a church.
- We will utilize our companion restroom rather than our main restrooms, and a facilities team member will disinfect after every use.
- Communion will be after the message, and taken in your seats, while our online host directs our online audience through communion. **Departing The Foundry Church**

- Family groups will exit through the main auditorium doors near the main restrooms. You will be dismissed as a group one by one by a greeter and guests will leave staggered to abide by social distancing guidelines.
- Please follow the arrows on the floor and exit through the second set of double doors.
- **There will be no congregating in any area of the building, including the lobby, at any time.**
